**Join Booster Club!**

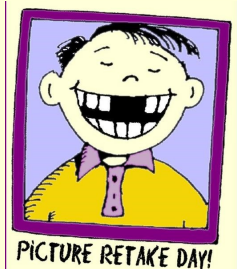
St. Paul's Booster Club is looking for new members to join our team.

All items can be brought to St. Paul School no later than October 26th. If you would like to donate, contact the school office.





