I want to thank the **42% of parents who responded to our surveys.** Here is a brief summary: . 89% of the surveys state that St. Paul is focused on student success. 95% of the surveys state Christ is the center of everything we do. 82% state the students relate to their teacher favorably. 86% state St. Paul has high expectations of their students. 92% state having good ratings for the school.

There were many parent and student comments. We, as a staff, have begun conversations on how to improve ourselves. We are currently working on:

1. Communicating clear expectations which will lead to less student anxiety.
2. Improving our classroom protocols and design which leads to less student confusion.
3. Building more genuine relationships with the students which will help disconnected students.
4. Giving more opportunities for students to have a voice which leads to less resistance.
5. Creating a more restorative culture.
6. Teaching "real life" lessons.

By combing through the comments we found the most common needs students have are: life skills, social skills, self-awareness, motivation and empathy. Organizational skills were high on the list also. The two parts of organizational skills are: homework, keeping their desk and locker organized . And organizing for homework - managing time especially for homework. Many times when homework is assigned students try to make it social time..

Side note: According to the World Economic Forum qualities such as: resilience, curiosity, lifelong learning, motivation, self-awareness are highly prized by colleges and businesses. Emotional intelligence is the #1 criteria for getting hired for the next 10 years!
