

## ST. PAUL MEMORIALS

Your St. Paul Church family extends our sympathy in this difficult time of loss. In an effort to be helpful, the following is a list of memorials you may wish to choose from in your loved one's name. Any memorial money should be brought to the church office and will be recorded in the Memorial Records Book.

1. **GENERAL FUND** – An open fund for which purposes will be decided in the future in consultation with the family of the deceased.
2. **MORTGAGE** – We moved into our new sanctuary with entryway, fellowship hall, offices, and four classrooms in 2007. The project cost was 4 million. Through faithful and generous giving, as of January 2013 our remaining mortgage is 1.6 million. Your gift may be designated directly toward the principal.
3. **ENDOWMENT FUND** – Investment income from this fund is used for church and school projects, to assist our staff in receiving additional education, and to help keep our tuition and education fees affordable for all.
4. **CARE/SHARE PROGRAM** – A fund used to help the occasional unfortunate person who appeals for assistance, perhaps for a utility bill or fuel.
5. **VIDEO/TAPE/SHUT-IN MINISTRY** – For the purchase of video and audio equipment used for the recording of our worship services for the distribution to members and community, especially to our elderly and shut-in members.
6. **MUSIC** – Enables Parish Music Director to purchase music for children's choirs, Bell choir, Church choirs, and Grandparent's Day.
7. **SCHOOL PROJECTS** – Technology, Accelerated Reader and Accelerated Math materials, etc., plus other school needs as determined by staff and the Board of Christian Education.
8. **EDUCATIONAL FUND** -- The Educational Fund helps parents who request and qualify for assistance in paying for their child's St. Paul education.
9. **PARISH LIBRARY** – Christian books and videos for the church library.
10. **RADIO MINISTRY** – Paid programming or devotions/advertising
11. **CHURCH-WORKER SCHOLARSHIP FUND** – These gifts provide scholarships to son and daughters of St. Paul who are studying to serve the Lord in fulltime church work, such as pastors, teachers, directors of music, or Christian education, etc.
