Do you love baking? Have a great recipe? Bake 'em up and join us at the picnic for a Cookie Baking Competition! We'll be awarding four prizes for the best cookies or bars brought in. We can't wait to taste your creations!

RULES:

1. Entered cookies/bars must be homemade.
2. Bring 3 cookies/bars plated for the judges and remainder of the batch for the Picnic attendees.
3. Must be registered by 11:30 am at the table in the narthex.

Criteria for Judging (a maximum total of 25 points may be awarded):

- a. Overall Appearance/Presentation (up to 5 points)
- b. Flavor (taste, balance of flavoring) (up to 5 points)
- c. Aroma (alluring smell) (up to 5 points)
- d. Texture/Consistency (evenly baked, doneness) (up to 5 points)
- e. Creativity/Originality (up to 5 points)

Scoring: Each judge assigns a numerical value for each cookie/bar without consultation with the other judges. The cookie/bar receiving the highest total numerical value in that age group is the winner. In case of a tie, judges will judge the final cookie/bar again, selecting the best of the final. Winners will be announced at the end of the competition around 1:30 p.m.
